1 Welcome & Apologies

The chair, Chris Goddard welcomed members to the meeting and apologies were noted.

2 Reports

2.1 Chairs Report from Chris Goddard

Chris reported on the clubs activities over the course of the year. As follows;

Instead of the APR previously held the club organised a Road Race as part of the North Road Race Series (4th June 2017). This event was organised by **Kenny Riddle** and on the start list there was 48 entrants. These riders rode a new course on the Black Isle which started & finished at Culbokie with a brutal climb at the end (many of the riders not have thank Kenny for this finish!). Even though the nature of the route meant a large number of helpers were required, on the day itself there were sufficient helpers and officials to assist and make it a successful event.

Mid-week Summer 10TT Series – The 4 events were organised by **Chris Goddard** with assistance from **John Mclean**. The number of entries to the events was good and it was reassuring to have 18 people registering for the whole series, even before there were entries for each single event. For each event the number of entries was 36 for the Event 1 (Daviot), 57 for Event 2 (Croachy), 35 for Event 3 (Daviot) and 43 for Event 4 (Croachy). On the whole the weather was kind to us which cannot be said for previous years when these events have been held.

As with all events, officials and volunteers are required to give up their free time to help make these events occur and be a success. So, on behalf of the club I'd like to thank everyone who has helped at events organised by the club.

I'd also like to mention **Susan Guest** (Secretary) and **Eric Innes** (Treasurer)

who will each be giving up their club positions after undertaking the roles for a number of years. Each of them have done a excellent job for the club, so on behalf of all club members I'd like to thank you for your contributions in each role.

2.2 Club Captains Reports from Kenny Riddle

Kenny reported on the clubs competitive activities over the last year. Highlights include;

The club promoted a road race on the May 4th with 5 lads getting in the top 14 with the highest being **Graham Doig** in a strong 2nd place.

Ross MacDonald followed up 2 weeks later winning the Angie Macdonald 25TT with an outstanding improvement with a 56.45.

Donald McRury had a stunning season winning the Ythan APR, 3rd in the Crit on Campus 4th cat race, then sprinting to another win in the Ythan 3/4ths road race. Also winning the 1st North series RR event in Moray to gain his 2nd cat licence before he took a rather bad crash in a road race down in Ayrshire.

Eric Innes turned things around after getting beat by Colin Duncan in the Bill Stuart 10tt to take the win the following day in the 25TT in 56.18.

Gavin Dempster was picking up top 10 results in National Bs and a 3rd in the Sam Robinson memorial.

We had 2 teams in the national TTT where the bar was well raised with both teams finishing in respectable places.

Gregor Grant has picked up the Scottish MTB XC 60+champs last month to add another national title to his palmares. Good to see **Anne Murray** back racing collected the vet title the same w/end in the Womens XC.

Kenny Riddle took the national vets 50+ RR title and the overall series for the year and stole a few TT wins through the year.

The north calendar finished off with a 5th place for **Kevin Smith** in the hard-fought Cairngorm APR, no ladies represented in the Sally Ann road race.

With the racing season still on the go, riders are still keen with some of the lads heading to Lammermuirs in a few weeks time. **Graham Doig** and **Kenny Riddle** then head to the masters tour of Mallorca mid-October.

On the ladies scene we continue to pick up results in the local TT's.

Congratulations to all our newer members who have been picking up prizes up in the Golspie crit races and learning how to work as a team in the popular new North RR series.

A large contingency of the club head off next Saturday to ride the North coast 500 in memory of the loss of **Marion Nicolson** and are raising funds for the Macmillan suite in Raigmore.
