Culbokie Race Road

Welcome to Moray Firth Cycling Club's road race based in the village of Culbokie, part of Scottish Cycling Norths Road Race Series.

Many thanks to all the Race Officials, Marshals and Helpers for kindly giving up their time to help with the event and also to Scottish Cycling for their support and assistance with promoting this event.

The Race HQ is at Findon Hall (IV7 8JX) situated on the left hand side of Culbokie as you drive through the village. The hall will be open on Sunday morning from 11:30am and has changing & toilet facilities and post-race refreshments; there is ample car parking to be found at the Hall, in grounds adjacent to the neighbouring Church and around the village itself.

Race House Keeping:

Signing On: All riders must sign on prior to the start of the race.

Rider Etiquette:

Please refer to the Race Smart leaflet enclosed with this race manual. Although this event is a Race please respect your fellow riders, Race Officials, Marshal's, spectators and local residents as without their support there would be no event.

Please also respect the country side in which you are racing. Please take all your litter, such energy bar and gel wrappers home with you. Riders seen discarding wrappers may be disqualified from the race at the Race jury's discretion.

Lapped Riders:

Should a rider be dropped during the race and does not wish to continue they should report to the Race Organiser (who will be based at Resolis Primary School). If the Race Organiser is not there the withdrawal should be reported to a marshal. Lapped riders must not actively participate in the peloton and should not give any pace to riders within the peloton. Lapped riders will be directed to go straight on pasted Resolis Primary School once the leaders have passed through this point and will therefore not complete the full race distance.

Race Service:

ALL riders are expected to provide a race worthy spare wheel for service. Riders requiring service are required to stop on the left hand side of the road. No service will be provided to riders stopping on the wrong side of the road. There is no guarantee of any service during the race. Service is dependent on how spread out the field is during the race. Even No.'s – FRONT and Odd No.'s – REAR

Race Numbers:

One race number is to be worn on the right hip area of race jerseys. A second race number is to be positioned on the rider's right shoulder blade. Numbers should not be cropped or obscured.

Following vehicles:

No following vehicles are permitted except by permission of the race organiser. Any

following vehicle interfering with the race convoy will result in the respective riders being disqualified.

Spectators:

You are welcome to spectate the event and we would suggest using the car parking at the Resolis Memorial Hall. From here you will be able to see the riders passing every 15mins before using the adjacent unclassified road that links onto the B9163 to return to the finish line in Culbokie, please leave in plenty of time from the Hall so that you do not interfere with the race convoy. Please do not use the Inn carpark; there is plenty car parking throughout the village.

Description:

Heading East out of Culbokie on the B9169 for 1.5miles to join the B9163 for 3.7miles to reach Resolis School; [Start of Race Circuit] Turn right onto unclassified road to Newhall passing the Resolis Free Church, Turn left and continue on unclassified road passing Newhall Memorial Hall, Bear right and continue on unclassified road to Newhall Bridge, Bear left to join the B9163 returning to Resolis Primary School via Balblair [End of Circuit]; complete a further 6 laps of this circuit; On completion of the circuits continue on the B9163 for approx. 3.7miles heading West towards Culbokie before right turn to Findon (B9163) and descend for approx. 1.5miles, Sharp left turn (still on B9163) to uphill finishing straight for 0.6miles at 7-10% gradient.

Rider safety guide

This race is run under British Cycling's technical regulations and under standard highway conditions therefore you MUST abide by the rules of the road.

Safety

You are not on closed roads and you will face oncoming traffic

Marshals (static or moto)

- Direct riders around the course and warn other road users a race is taking place
- Marshals do not create road closures or make it safe to race on the right hand side of the road

Actions

- You are responsible for your own actions
- Race on the left hand side of the road – do not cross solid white lines and always avoid crossing broken white lines
- Persistent offenders will be penalised (eg disqualification or a fine)
- If necessary the race will be stopped

Responsibility

- Look after each other, behave responsibly and safely
- Do not take unnecessary risks - your actions could have serious consequences

Think

- About your position on the road
- Rider behaviour is critical to protecting the future of road racing
- We all have a part to play
