Moray Firth Cycling Club - 22 Mile TT

This is the information on the course for the 22m TT which starts at the crossroads at the top of Essich hill and McBean hill, which is part of this summer's virtual series of time trials.

The Start


The start is on the crossroads between the roads from Essich and McBean hills and the road to Loch Duntelchaig.

The Course

The course follows the minor road to the top of Dores hill, turn left onto the B862 at approximately 2.9 miles. It then follows the B862 to Torness and continues to the junction with the B851, where you turn left onto the B851 at approximately 8.1 miles. Continue on the B851 through Croachy, please take care here as the road narrows on the entrance and exit of the village. At Inverarnie you turn left onto the B861 at approximately 18.9 miles. Continue on this road to the finish at the entrance to Newton of Leys which is on the right hand side of the road at approximately 22.4 miles (before you start the decent to Inverness). The course is as illustrated below:



The Finish

The finish is located on the B861, you pass under the Pylons and the finish is opposite the entrance to Newton of Leys before the road descends into Inverness
